

Canadians can work for a peace with justice

Until the State of Israel complies with the obligations of international law and covenants in their treatment of Palestinians, Canadians must:

Call upon our organizations, universities, financial institutions, trade unions, and community, religious and social groups to divest from corporations whose activities serve to support Israel's military occupation of Palestinian territory.

Boycott Ahava and other Israeli goods from occupied territory. When in doubt, ask the merchant about the origin of the product.

Divest personally from companies with Israeli military contracts.

The Jewish National Fund is the owner of most of the confiscated Palestinian land. It has been allowed tax-deductible status in Canada. Israeli Bonds also finance the illegal settlements.

Refuse to donate to organizations that support settlements and/or handle confiscated Palestinian land and resources.

Continue this campaign until the occupation is ended in conformity with international law and with the requirements of respect for human rights.

Organize educational talks, workshops and educational displays in your schools, organizations, community centres and places of worship.

We, representatives of Palestinian civil society, call upon international civil society organizations and people of conscience all over the world to impose broad boycotts and implement divestment initiatives against Israel similar to those applied to South Africa in the apartheid era.
